The Fox Cities Chamber golf outing is scheduled for Monday, July 25 at Ridgeway Country Club in Neenah and will have a new twist this year.

A "Chopper Dropper / The Big Ball Drop" is being introduced. Five hundred tickets at a cost of \$50.00 each will be sold. At approximately 5 p.m. on the day of the event, 500 numbered golf balls will be dropped near the 18th hole. The ball in or closest to the cup wins \$10,000.

The outing will remain in a best ball scramble format, with a shot gun start at 11:00 a.m. A boxed lunch will be available to the golfers and a reception with a large variety of hors d'oeuvres will be offered at the conclusion of the day.

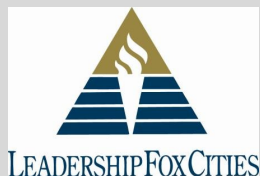
