The Fox Cities Chamber of Commerce & Industry, in conjunction with the Heart of the Valley Chamber, have arranged for a luncheon event with Congressman Reid Ribble. The gathering will include a panel discussion with area business leaders on the impact of state and federal regulations on local businesses.

Invited guests include Andrew Card and Evan Bayh.

Card served as U.S. Secretary of Transportation under President George H. W. Bush and the White House Chief of Staff under George W. Bush. Card was known as the iron man of the White House, as he was the longest-serving White House chief of staff since the Eisenhower administration.

Evan Bayh first held public office as the Secretary of State of Indiana, elected in 1986. He held the position for only two years before being elected Governor where he successfully advocated for state welfare reform, tax cuts, and fiscal discipline. He left his office after completing two terms and briefly took a job lecturing at Indiana University Kelley School of Business, before being elected to the U.S. Senate seat once held by his father, Birch Bayh.

On February 15, 2010, Bayh announced he would not seek reelection to the Senate in 2010.

Both men have expressed grave concerns for mountainous increases in the

volume and scope of business regulation.

China Trip -- Oct. 31 to Nov. 8

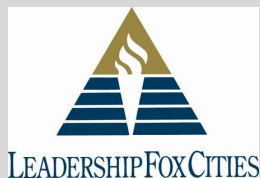
